

HANDLE Intermediate Course Atlanta, Georgia

Dates:

Session I is January 12-17 and Session II is Feb. 9-14. Both sessions are required.

Format of the Course:

The Intermediate Course will take place in two separate one-week segments in order to provide students the opportunity to learn new information, have time to reflect on and integrate that learning, and thereby feel ready and confident in putting it into practice.

In the first week students will review developmental systems, learn the screening tool, learn several new activities, observe some screenings, and screen each other.

During the interval between segments, students will be expected to practice activities, follow through with their own programs and reflect on that experience, and do practice screenings on family and/or friends.

Upon return for the second week, students will review and discuss the homework assignments, learn how to present screening results to clients, and participate in supervised screenings with clients from the public.

Demonstration of competence in using the Screening tool and in performing and teaching the HANDLE activities, and satisfactory completion of the Interactive Learning Tool after the course, will qualify the student to become a Certified HANDLE Screener.
