The HANDLE Screening Tool, applied for individuals age 5 to adult with learning and attentional difficulties, also identifies those at risk for such challenges.

Learn many appropriate activities and other suggestions to enhance functions for those you screen.

Successful completion of the entire course, 100% attendance, take-home exam, homework, skills check-offs, and affiliation with The HANDLE Institute, will qualify you for certification as a HANDLE Screener.

Build on your understanding of HANDLE through:

- ◆ 50 hours of instruction on screening and in-depth understanding of the concepts and activities taught in the Introductory course plus additional HANDLE activities that can be applied in classrooms as well as with individuals.
- ◆ 24 hours of supervised practicum over 3 screening days, identifying weak systems, determining appropriate recommendations, and presenting the findings to client families plus a half-day for discussing how to proceed from here.
- ◆ 20 hours of small group and individual practical experience.
- ◆ Between and after modules one and two, time for personal reflection, study, homework, and practice.

Prerequisite:

You must have taken the HANDLE Introductory course no earlier than 2009. If your course was earlier than that, you must first take another course, as a “Refresher.” Check the HANDLE website find out dates and locations for Introductory courses scheduled between now and the time of the this course. The Screener Certification Program is a prerequisite for Practitioner Certification Program.
